Item No. II Revoking alley in Square 135 - on motion of Alderwoman Mathies, seconded by Alderman Burris this matter was tabled until next month in order to get opinion from Village Lawyer. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.

Item No. III Adopt Budget for Fiscal Year July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012 – on motion of Alderman Burris, seconded by Alderman Willie that Budget for Fiscal Year July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.

Item No. IV Peddler Permits – One Citizen concern in reference to peddlers in the Village of Folsom, having them pay peddlers license and having liability Insurance.

Item No. V El Milagro Mexican Store – Approved business owner for a Beer & liquor License for this fiscal year, on motion of Alderman Burris, seconded by Alderman Willie. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.

Item No. VI Utility Adjustments – Citizens were concern in reference to utility rates being adjusted for pool owners when filled.

Item No. VII Resolution for Amendment No. 1 – Due to lack of information needed for Amendment No. 1, this matter was tabled until next month in order get an opinion from clerk. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.

Item No. VIII – Board selected St. Tammany Farmer as our Official Journal for a term of one year, on motion of Alderman Burris, seconded by Alderman Willie. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.

Item No. IX – Citizen Judy Parson showed interest about being a part of the Village of Folsom community & Activity Center, Ms. Parson stated she was interested in raising revenue for activity center and bringing in other citizens to share their talents of arts and crafts with others in the Village of Folsom. Also introduced were Architects Josha LaBorde and Carolina Sanchez who stated that they would like to donate their service and time to drawing up our new Activity Center.

Item No. X - Other business, recognition was given to Maintenance Supervisor and his crew for their hard work on beautifying landsite located behind Folsom Town Hall.

Also, in other business upcoming events and information was introduced to citizens and board about the First Fridays Block Party, Youth Night, and Village Market.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned on motion of Alderman Burris, seconded by Alderman Willie. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.
