The meeting was called to order and a quorum established. The invocation and pledge were led by Alderman Bickham. The Agenda was amended on motion of Alderman Holliday, seconded by Alderman Bickham to include the following: 1) Heisser Construction, 2) Steve Villavaso. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.

Item No. I Engineer's report – Kiley Bates reported that start-up for the sewer project was on Friday. He also reported that the project is substantially complete and requested that the project be accepted. Mr. Bates reported that due to recent weather conditions they are looking for some type of protective covering/shelter for the injection system as well as a bollard system to prevent damages from dump trucks. The project was accepted as substantially complete on motion of Alderman Wilt, seconded by Alderman Holliday. (3 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.

Item No. II Renewal of Beer/Liquor license – the applications submitted for renewal were approved on motion of Alderman Holliday, seconded by Alderman Bickham. (2 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.

Item No. III Adopt ordinance amending Code of Ordinances, Chapter 9 Alcohol Beverage Control – after having held a public hearing the ordinance amending Code of Ordinances, Chapter 9 Alcohol Beverage Control was adopted on motion of Alderman Wilt, seconded by Alderman Holliday. (2 Yeas, 0 Nays) The motion carried.

Item No. IV Christmas Decorating Contest winners – Mrs. Wactor presented the residential trophy to Wayne, Dawn and Travis King and the commercial trophy to Wendell Miller of Inland Nursery.

Item No. V Steve Villavaso – Mr. Villavaso reported that they have proceeded with work on the Comprehensive Plan which they had begun in 2008. He stated that it a twelve month contract which will be completed in December 2010. Mr. Villavaso stated that the Comprehensive Plan will be presented to the Zoning Commission for adoption and the updated Zoning Ordinance and Map will presented to the Board of Aldermen. He stated that the entire code of ordinances will be updated which will include participation by the mayor, board of aldermen and the public.

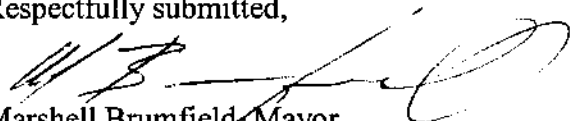
Item No. VI Heisser Construction – Mr. Atkins reported that the subdivision has already been accepted as per built drawings. However, tonight they are requesting acceptance of the infrastructure. Mr. Atkins reported that there is only one problem and that is the entrances to the subdivision not being wide enough to accommodate the cement trucks going in and out for ongoing construction as well as the garbage trucks. It was recommended that the Mr. Heisser increase the radius and extend the pipes at both entrances/exits to the subdivision.

At this time Greg Saurage announced that the Mardi Gras Parade is February 16th at 1:30. He also announced that Ms. Betty Mathies is the Grand Marshall and the king and queen will be announced later.

Also at this time Mrs. SueEllen Eyre requested that something be done about the litter in the Village. She suggested that an anti-litter campaign be started.
