Section 4.1 Elections Adopted

The Village Of Folsom, hereby adopts the plan for holding the municipal elections of the offices of Mayor, Board of aldermen, and Police Chief at the congressional elections, in accordance with Revised Statute 18:402, Subsection B.

Section 4.2 Term

Pursuant to said Revised Statute 18:402B, municipal elections for municipal officers as designated hereinabove shall be held every four years with the first such primary election to be held the last Saturday in September, 1986 and with the first such general election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1986. The officers elected shall take office on the first day January, following their election and shall hold their office for four years.

Section 4.3 Conditions

The terms of office of the present Mayor, Board of Aldermen and Chief of Police shall not be decreased by the passage of the ordinance, and those officers serving on the effective date of this ordinance shall continue to serve until their successors are sworn into office.
